Music scholars: We seek to recruit 3 or 4 singers for the 2020-21 season (September through May). Candidates should be actively studying music in the Victoria area. They do not need to be voice specialists, but they need to be reasonably accomplished student musicians. Choral scholars are expected to make a commitment to at least one term, and preferably a full season from September through the end of May. Choral scholars should be prepared to work with the Victoria Arion Male Choir and the Music Director with an end to participating in at least 2 concerts a term, or 4 concerts in a full season. The candidates would be expected to audition before the choir's Music Director. At the discretion of the Music Director, there may be opportunities to perform solos and to conduct selected pieces. Weekly rehearsals are on Monday evenings.
