Choral scholars

Every year the choir looks for 3 or 4 students with a strong interest in singing and music performance. Applicants will audition for the choir's musical director, Sean Lampard-Quicke. At his discretion there may be opportunities for the successful choral scholars to perform solos, to conduct selected pieces and to provide technical or musical support for the choir. Choral scholars are expected to join us for at least one term and preferably for the full season from September the end of May. During the year there may be up to 4 concerts and shorter performances may occur at smaller community locations such as senior residences. Weekly rehearsals are on Monday evenings from 7PM to 9PM
